

Appointment of Operator for the Offshore Wind Power Project off the Coast of Yuza Town, Yamagata Prefecture, Japan

Yamagata Yuza Offshore Wind LLC, a special purpose company (SPC) established through a joint investment by Marubeni Corporation (hereinafter, "Marubeni"), The Kansai Electric Power Co., Inc. (hereinafter, "KEPCO"), BP IOTA Holdings Limited (hereinafter, "BPIOTA"), Tokyo Gas Co., Ltd. (hereinafter, "Tokyo Gas"), and Marutaka Corporation (hereinafter, "Marutaka"), has been appointed to operate an offshore wind farm off the coast of Yuza Town in Yamagata Prefecture, Japan (hereinafter, the "Project") as of December 24. Marubeni Offshore Wind Development Corporation(hereinafter "MOWD"), as a business partner, will promote the Project along with Marubeni.

The Project involves the construction, maintenance, and operation of a 450,000 kW bottom-fixed offshore wind farm. Through this Project, the parties aim to contribute to the development of local communities, the vitalization of the domestic offshore wind industry, and the realization of a zero-carbon society.

Marubeni group established the Marubeni Long-Term Vision on Climate Change in March 2021 and positions Green Strategy as one of its basic principles for the enhancement of corporate value in the Marubeni Mid-Term Management Strategy, GC2024. MOWD develops offshore wind projects around the world, and operates Japan's first large-scale offshore wind power project at Akita Port and Noshiro Port in Akita Prefecture. MOWD will pursue a progressive approach to expanding its offshore wind business, leveraging the know-how and experience it has gained through these power projects.


